Holy Spirit Catholic School

Holy Spirit School is a parish school in the Diocese of Arlington that educates children from Pre-Kindergarten through Eighth Grade.

Holy Spirit School possesses the defining characteristics upon which authentic Catholic education is built. Namely, we are centered in the person of Jesus Christ; we contribute to the evangelizing mission of the Church; we are distinguished by excellence; we are committed to educating the whole child; we are steeped in a Catholic worldview; we are sustained by Gospel witness; we are shaped by communion and community; and we are accessible to students with varying abilities.

Holy Spirit School's Resource program yearly adapts to meet the ever changing needs of our students and those in the Diocese. They offer an inclusive, faith-filled environment for students with intellectual disabilities and significant learning needs.

They are fortunate to have experienced and licensed special education teachers along with a certified academic language therapist to provide resource services to all of our students who require learning support.

The team is supported by paraeducators. The Resource Teachers provide individual and small group instruction in the Resource Room, as well as providing push-in support to students in the classroom. Our Resource Teachers also work to assist teachers, providing them tools and techniques to use within their own classrooms.



St. Anthony of Padua School
Arlington, VA

St. Anthony of Padua School fosters a love of Jesus and His Gospel, forming lifelong disciples in service to the Church and society while empowering its students to achieve academic excellence in a culturally diverse environment.

The Resource Center provides specialized support to students with a documented learning disability or a demonstrated learning need. The resource teachers provide small group or individual instruction in the resource room, visit classrooms to work with small groups, share lessons or strategies on studying and test taking, and partner with teachers to implement accommodations.

Students with a documented learning disability may receive a Student Assistance Plan (SAP), which lists the classroom and testing accommodations that the student will receive. Parents are an integral part of the process, and are obligated to share educational/psychological testing results and any resulting plan with the school.

St. Anthony's provides students with mild to moderate intellectual and developmental disabilities access to an individualized, inclusive Catholic education. This gives students the opportunity to grow socially, spiritually, and academically in a Catholic environment. A primary goal for each student is to be as fully integrated as possible into the total life of the school community.

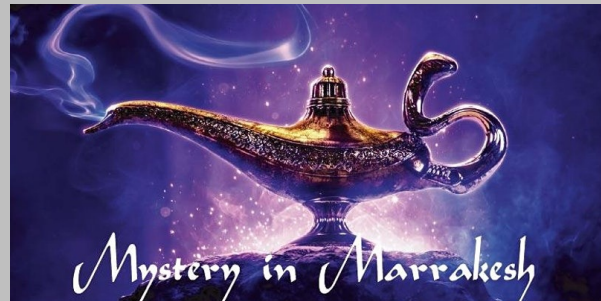
